- The UMID DNA database is established to streamline the process of identifying unidentified human bodies and/or remains and locating missing persons through the utilisation of DNA fingerprinting technology
- A civil database act as a repository of information relating to the physical description of the deceased including their belongings such as piece of clothing and other possessions. It can help the police to get an identification and subsequently contact and inform the family.
- Trainees will undergo training on how to use the Database, including step-by-step guidance on accessing and submitting phenotypic as well as genotypic data related to the deceased.
